

Replacing the decals on your equipment:

1. The most important part of putting on a new decal is preparing the surface. The best way to decal a door is flat, so remove it from the unit if possible. You may also need to remove any switch guards or steel frames around the timer and/or visual display. Always be careful when working with steel, the edges tend to be very sharp and could cause injury.
2. To remove the existing decal, use a razor blade to cut small strips and carefully peel off in pieces.
3. The surface needs to be thoroughly cleaned with a citrus based solvent to remove old residue.
4. Next, using a spray bottle filled with mostly water, a spoonful of Dawn dish washing detergent and a small amount of alcohol, spray the door and the back of the decal. This helps the decal to slide into position easily.
5. After the decal is in position, use a small squeegee to remove excess water.
6. Use a sharp safety knife to trim around the timer window and/or visual display.
7. Replace frames and switch guards. Hang the door back on the machine. It will take time to air dry, that is why it is best to replace decals in warmer weather for quicker drying time.
